Paramotor World Distance Record

7:15 am

The Mexican pilot Fernando Iriarte takes off in the first attempt from Puerto Vallarta, Jalisco in north direction with favorable winds.

11:00 am

On one hour Fernando Iriarte will be over Mazatlán with optimal conditions to obtain the challenge, flying at a speed average of 85 km/hr.

1:00 pm

The pilot of the Pepsi Max Team has flown an approximated distance of 500 kilometers.

3:29 pm

Fernando Iriarte is flying over The Mochis, Sinaloa, to an altitude of 1.500 meters, because the conditions of the wind are more favorable at this height. The passage that takes our pilot is of approximately 790 kilometers.

5:42 pm

The pilot is flying over Huatamambo, Sonora. At this moment he has flown 940 kilometers in 10 hours.

9:08 pm

The great challenge was fulfilled, Fernando Iriarte breaks the Paramotor World Distance Record, the pilot flew 1.144 kilometers in 13 hours with 53 minutes, landing in Bay of Kino, Sonora.
